Required delivery time is not sufficient by considering approval of documents, Production, TPI & transit time, however we request you to consider delivery time at least 12-14 weeks.	Tender condition prevails.
2	8	63	Third Party Inspection	The inspection shall be carried out by TPIA / Purchaser representative at bidder's works as per approved QAP and inspection charges will be borne by Purchaser (CUGL). However, in case where ever inspection is to be carried out by supplier only then supplier will bear the inspection expenses.	In case of authorised representative, the inspection shall be carried out at manufacturer's place and not at bidder's place. Please define TPI scope clearly.	Inspection shall be carried out by CUGL hired Third party only at bidder's place before dispatch of material. In case of authorized supplier, the inspection carried out at manufacturing unit, the cost of same shall be borne by the bidder.  Tender condition prevails.
3			Clause No 6 of SCC		<u>Delivery Period of 6 Weeks</u> As we understand, Delivery Period of 6 Weeks means material shall be ready and shall be loaded to truck for dispatch within 6 Weeks. Also date of LR shall be considered as date for PRS calculation because in this times it is very difficult to make material available at site within 6 Weeks, because document submission and approval cycle will take at least 2 Weeks and further to that manufacturing will take at least 4 Weeks. <b>So, please confirm that our understanding is correct and date of LR shall be considered for PRS calculation</b>	Bidder understanding is correct
4			Painting Requirement for 4 Bar - 21 mbar regulators		As per Clause No.6, it is written that painting needs to be carried out. We would like to confirm that regulators in this category generally does not come with painting and we are supplying same to all gas companies across India including CUGL. Also we would like to confirm that material used is corrosion resistance. <b>Please confirm your acceptance for same</b>	
5			Technical Datasheet of 4 Bar - 21 mbar regulators		As per notes of datasheet end connections are asked of size 1/2". Male X 1/2" Female and 3/4" Male X 1/2" Female From attached specification, we understand M/s. CUGL requires end connection of 1/2" Inlet and 1/2" Outlet with Female Loose Nut We do have product which has end connection of 1/2" x 1/2" NPT Female Loose Nut and we do not think there are extra adapters required as that will unnecessary add costing of final product. <b>So, please confirm your acceptance to end connection of 1/2" X 1/2" NPT Female Loose Nut of brass material with suitable washers but without additional adapters</b>	Bidder has to provide additional Inlet Brass adapter ( 1/2" Male X 1/2" Female) and Outlet Brass adapter (3/4" Male X 1/2" Female) for Connectivity the Downstream & Upstream of Pipeline. Tender condition prevails.
